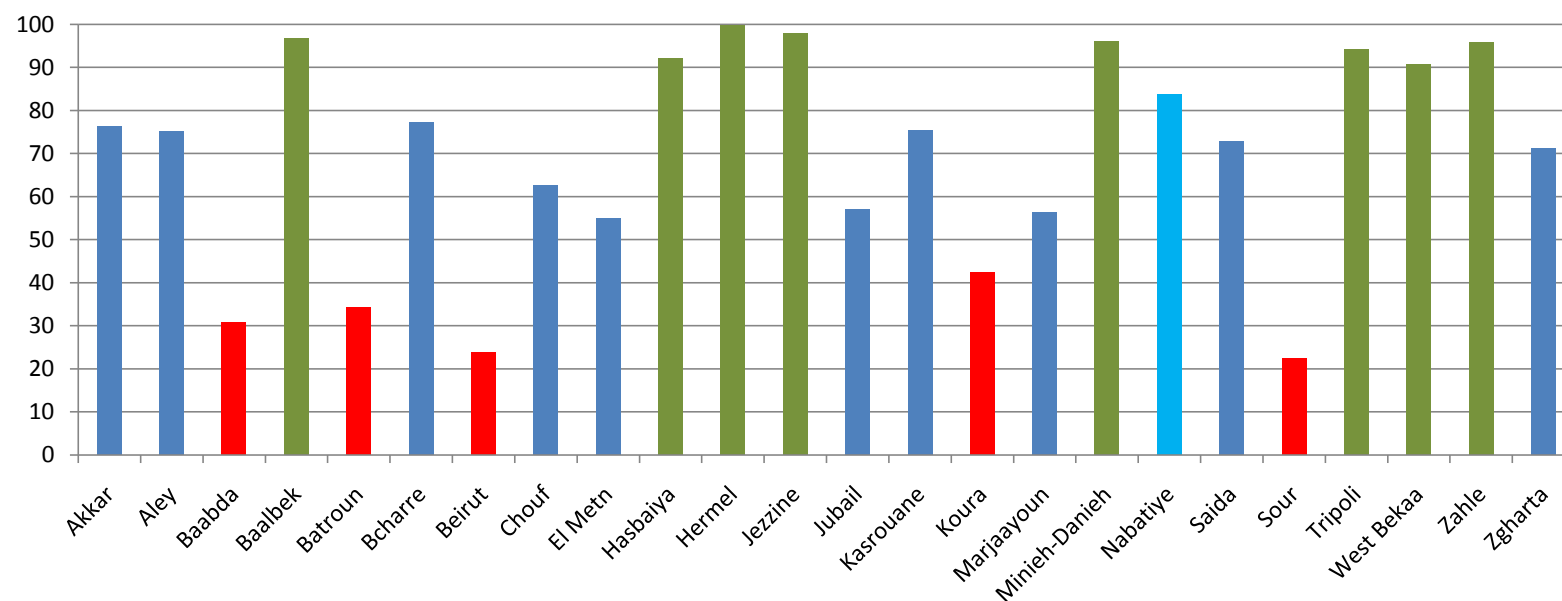
24 qadas (except rashaya , bint jbeil and part of shouf) participated in the Mop-up 2014 first round

the proportion of syrians among total vaccinated children is 55%

NB: If we considered the Target of the Post Evaluation Campaign PEC we could have reached 100% coverage in some Qadas.

However and through the visits MoPH has conducted with UNICEF and WHO to Qada physicians, and after discussion with communities and Qada team targets were modified and increased according to the Qada team suggestions

Also note that Mop-up monitoring visits were conducted in coordination with WHO and UNICEF
